Building Words

Grades 1-6



Purpose of this activity:

To reinforce phonemic awareness, spelling, and decoding skills by physically manipulating letters to form words.

What you'll need:

Letter tile cards and a list of target words.

How to play:

- 1. Cut out and place the set of letter tile cards and the word list you are working with on the work space in front of you.
- 2. Build each word on the list using the letter tile cards.
- 3. After building the word, read it aloud, break it down into phonemes, and then reassemble it. (Phonemes are sounds in a word. For example, cat would be broken down to /k/ /a/ /t/; shake would be broken down to /sh/ /a/ /k/, etc.),
 - *Challenge: Spell the word backwards after completing the word in it's original order.
 - ** Challenge: Create new words using the same tiles.
