Building With Prepositional Phrases

Grades 4 - 8



Purpose of this activity:

To help students with dyslexia identify and understand the function of prepositional phrases within sentences. Students engaging in this interactive activity will learn to recognize prepositional phrases and how these phrases provide additional details about where, when, or how something happens.

What you'll need:

A few pieces of paper, a pencil for each student, and the "Building with Prepositional Phrases" phrase bank.

How to play:

- 1. Choose which player is going to go first. That player will write a short sentence about the topic they choose.
- 2. The second player will choose a prepositional phrase from the bank and add it to the sentence. The phrase you choose needs to make sense. It needs to fit into the sentence and add interest.
- 3. The paper is given back to the first player and another prepositional phrase needs to be added. Make sure you choose another phrase that fits into the sentence and adds interest.
- 4. Continue passing the paper back and forth as many times as you are able, adding phrases until it is impossible to add any more. You might only get two or three phrases, but give it your best effort.
- 5. Once you have completed the sentence with as many phrases as you can, move on to a new sentence. The second player will write the new sentence and the first player will add the prepositional phrase.
 - * Remember, a prepositional phrase gives information about where, when, or how something happens. Make sure that the phrases you choose meet that need for something in your sentence. Choose where you are going to put the phrase in the sentence. It will not always be at the end of the sentence.
