Comparing Quantities

Grades 1 - 3



Purpose of this activity:

To help students develop a basic understanding of counting, comparing quantities, and recognizing greater than, less than, or equal to relationships.

What you'll need:

Two-color disks (red on one side, yellow on the other), a pencil, and the "Greater Than, Less Than or Equal To" work mat.

How to play:

- 1. Set the two-color disks, the work mat, and the comparison cards, on your work surface.
- 2. Take a handful of the disks in one hand. Randomly drop the disks on the table surface.
- 3. Count how many disks landed on each color.
- 4. Compare the two quantities and use a comparison card or say aloud which quantity is greater, less, or if they are equal.
- 5. Record the answer on the work mat.
- 6. Repeat steps 2-5 as many times as you would like but at last 10 times.
- 7. Once you have completed the last round, look at the work mat and answer the questions at the bottom of the work mat.
