Multiplication Grids

Grades 2 - 5



Purpose of this activity:

To learn and practice multiplication facts in a concrete way.

What you'll need:

Multiplication flash cards and wax-covered yarn.

How to play:

- 1. Place flash cards, face down, on the work space. Choose one and turn it face up.
- 2. Look at the first number in the fact and get that number of wax-covered yarns. Then look at the second number and take that number of wax-covered yarns.
- 3. Lay the first set of yarns across the page and then take the second set and lay them across the other lines so it makes a grid.
- 4. Once you have the grid complete, count the places where the intersections are to get the answer for the multiplication problem.
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 until you have completed at least 20 problems (but if you feel up to it, complete as many as you want).
