

Pattern Practice

Grades K - 2



Purpose of this activity:

To learn to recognize and repeat different types of patterns.

What you'll need:

Wax-coated yarn and pattern cards *optional: a piece of plain paper to protect the work surface from the wax residue).

How to play:

1. Stack the pattern cards, face down, on the work surface.
2. Choose a pattern card from the pile.
3. Using the yarn pieces, recreate the pattern. The patterns need to match exactly, so make sure you are looking at shapes when making your patterns. *If you have multiple colors of wax yarn see if you can match the shape AND the colors.
4. Once you complete the pattern, hold the card under the pattern to make sure it is in the same order. Once you have checked them, take the pattern apart and choose a new card.
5. Repeat steps 2-4 until you have completed all of the pattern cards or have completed at least 5 patterns.
